The Idea behind the Conference

In a wide variety of developing countries homeopaths and small homeopathic organisations are actively involved in running homeopathic clinics and providing homeopathic training. Some homeopaths have even decided to permanently live in Africa or another region where medical help is scarce. These people do wonderful work because homeopathy, being cheap, safe and effective, is an ideal system of health for developing countries.

To run a project in a developing country is not easy. Being a good homeopath is a precondition but a lot more skills are required to make it a success. The amount of work is enormous, the pitfalls and obstacles manifold. We therefore thought that bringing all the different groups of dedicated people who have taken it upon themselves to bring homeopathy to developing countries would be a good idea. Many projects are aimed at training local people to apply homeopathy and become actively involved in the clinics being set up. The conference is also especially intended for these local homeopaths. Their participation will change the conference from one *about* developing countries into one with homeopaths *from* developing countries.

We will also invite other homeopaths to participate and will make a programme for the first day that will be interesting for them and meets accreditation standards. The second day will be used for workshops directly connected to setting up and running homeopathic initiatives in developing countries.

The conference offers two programmes to the representatives of different projects:

Day 1: "Homeopathy - First Class Medicine for the Third World": lectures and poster presentations.

Day 2: "In Giving Everyone Receives": interactive workshop.

The conference will take place in the 'Leerhotel Het Klooster'. This facility enjoys a beautiful setting in a former monastery but is reasonably priced because catering students run the hotel and conference centre as part of their training.

Our Invitation for You

Homeopathy in developing countries has often meant no more than a small stand at a conference or a news item in a journal. We feel that this subject is important enough to devote a whole conference to. If you share this feeling we hope you will help us make this conference a reality, and so indirectly support many projects in developing countries.

By sponsoring the conference you will make it possible for us cover the travelling expenses of participants from developing countries that otherwise would not have been able to come – costs €10,000. A further €10,000 would enable us to invite one to two persons of each organisation active in developing countries to attend for free. These people work on a voluntary basis and often even pay their own expenses. Free tickets will include the two days of the conference, two nights at the conference hotel, breakfast, lunch on both days and dinner at the first day of the conference. A total budget of €20,000 would enable us to receive 36 non-paying participants including 10-15 homeopaths from developing countries.

We ask you to participate by sponsoring this event and hope the above will inspire you to do so. For this we offer the following options:

1 - to sponsor the conference with **€2,000-€5,000**. We will place your **name and logo** on all flyers and documents and mention your name in a conference report published in a leading homeopathic journal. We will **hand out** your company's flyers or documentation to all participants or allow you to have a booth.

2 - to sponsor the conference with **€500-€2,000**. Your **name** will be placed on all flyers and documents and will be mentioned in a conference report published in a leading homeopathic journal.

3 – to (additionally) sponsor the participation of 1 or more participants from developing countries with **€1,000/€2,000** etc.

We are open to discuss other options with you if you feel these would be more appropriate.

Thank you for your attention. A growing number of homeopaths travel to developing countries to offer treatment and to give education. Your contribution to make their work more effective by sponsoring a conference where they can share their ideas and experiences is most welcome.
